The formal father of capitalism was a Scottish economist, philosopher, and author named **Adam Smith** (1720-1790).

He authored two major publications on that subject: *The Theory of Moral Sentiments* (1759) and *An Inquiry into the Nature and Causes of the Wealth of Nations* (1776)

Definition: **Capitalism** is an economic system where material goods and wealth and the means for creating material goods and wealth are owned and controlled by private _____ and or _____.

Definition: **Crony capitalism** describes an economy in which success in business is contingent on _____ between business and government politicians and bureaucrats.

In 1905 a German sociologist, economist and politician named **Max Weber** authored a book called **The Protestant Ethic and the Spirit of Capitalism**. It was considered a founding text in economical sociology and general sociological studies.
