Types of Sin:
First, original sin: Original sin is the teaching or doctrine that basically states all people are sinners by and have a bent towards sinning because of the sin committed by Adam in the Garden. References: Genesis 7:4; Romans 5:12 (see screen)
Second, personal sin:  Personal sin is the type of <b>sin committed by people day</b> because of original sin, ranging from white lies to murder.
We sin in 4 basic ways:  We sin when we the things that God says not to do.  We sin when we do do what God says to do.  We sin when we things we should not say.  We sin when we things we should not think.
Third, imputed sin: Imputed sin happened after Moses gave the law to man and when a person violated the law it was against them.  Reference: Romans 5:13 (see screen)
