What I believe is one of the biggest struggles of the church to understand is that the church is the one institution that is designed not just for those inside, but for those who have yet to become a part of it. We need to understand the need to share the message with them in such a way that they want to know what the Christian life is all about!

III. The \_\_\_\_\_, Jesus Christ in a church that is Alive – v5, "Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria, and preached Christ to them."

Philip had one goal, one focus, and one purpose! He preached Christ! He did not set out to make a name for himself. Philip was focused on Moving with THE message about THE MAN.

The focus Was Jesus in Paul's preaching likewise – **1 Cor. 2:2**, "For I determined not to know anything among you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified."

Jesus was the message that Peter preached to the High Priest in Acts 4:12, "Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."
