No other fact in the Christmas story is more important than the virgin birth. The virgin birth identified Jesus as the promised Messiah and enabled God to also become a man and ultimately the Savior. To quote the Creed of Chalcedon, the Lord Jesus Christ is 'one person in two natures, unmixed, unchanged, undivided, (and) inseparable."
